- . Write one reason <u>supporting</u> the following statements.

  Write at least two sentences with enough persuative information. (24)
- 1. Small babies need their mothers' care more than anything else.
- R) Baby and mother form a bond with one another in the womb. Nurses and other caregivers can care for the physical needs of an infant, but they cannot give the unconditional, unwavering love that a mother can give. This love that comes from that bond is essential to an infant's normal development.
- D) Small babies are not able to take of themselves, so they need their mothers care. The mother must prepare the food and feed it to the baby. If she does not do this, then the baby will die.
- 2. Women should work outside the home if they can leave their childrens' care to somebody else.
- R) Caregivers these days have been given a large amount of training and are more educational than most parents on the development of a child. Therefore, a child will benefit from being in daycare environment. They will be both intellectually and socially stimulated by the caregivers in daycare.
- D) Living in Japan is expensive, so mothers should work if someone else can take care of their children. If the mother works she can earn extra money for the family and use that money to buy things for the family.
- 3. In Japan entrance exams to colleges are not fair.
- R) Entrance exams to colleges are not fair because some students get nervous taking tests. Therefore, a nervous student will do less well than a confident student even though they have equal academic abilities.
- D) Entrance exams in Japan are not fair. A student's future is based on one test they taken in the last year of high school, which is not fair. It is possible for a student to get good grades, but fail the entrance exam, so the student cannot go the college.
- 4. Universities should put more emphasis on high school grades in selecting the applicants.
- R) Universities should put more emphasis on high school grades, because grades show a student's typical academic performance, rather than their performance on a single test. A student may be lazy, but study hard only for the entrance exam and then proceed to fail out of university. As well, another student may be sick or nervous on the day of the exam and do poorly, even though they are intelligent enough to excel in everyday life in their chosen university.
- D) High school grades are a best way to select applicants for universities. Grades show the students efforts over their entire time in high school, while entrance exams do not. They only show that the student can study hard for a short period, and that they can study in order to take one test.

- . Write one rebuttal <u>against</u> the following statements.

  Write at least two sentences with enough persuative information. (12)
- 1. Women should stay at home till all her children become old enough to go to school.
- R) While I understand the idea that someone should stay home with the children, I disagree with the idea that it should be the woman. Why can't the man stay home as well? Men and women are equals and should share the responsibility of raising a child. The idea that only women should stay home is sexist and old-fashioned.
- D) Children can receive good care from a person that is not their mother, so it is okay for a woman to work outside the house. If the woman works, she can give her child things that she could not if she did not work.
- 2. Evaluating students only by high school grades is the ideal way for universities to select them.
- R) This is not the ideal way to select students because at times teachers can be biased or prone to error. They may give a student that they get along with better grades, or they may be tired and frustrated one day and mark a batch of students harshly. Therefore, evaluating students only by high school grades is not the best way to select them for universities.
- D) Using high school grades is not the ideal way to select students. If every student takes the same entrance exam then the university has a way to easily compare students and to see their true ability.
- . Write your idea about the following topic in about 50 words. (14) These days, many shops and restaurants are open till late at night. This is true especially in big cities. I think we should make some rule to order these shops and restaurants to close at nine o'clock. Indeed, these late-night shops are convenient for those who work at night, but they have bad influence on ordinary people.
  - R) I don't understand why having shops open later than 9 p.m. would be a bad influence on people. While it may encourage people to stay up later, that isn't a bad thing. Parents can decide on bedtimes for children. Adults should be able to choose when they want to be awake and when they want to sleep as well as when they want to go out and eat. Therefore, I think shops should stay open late because there is no reason why that would be a bad influence on people, and because adults have the right to choose how they conduct their lives.
  - D) I disagree with the idea that shops and restaurants should close early. These kinds of businesses have to purposes for being open; to make money, and to provide a service people want. If shops and restaurants close early, then they will lose money and not give people the service they need. The reason they are open late is because people need them too be.
